Teams are invited to enter for the Charities Cup. Each team must have at least one disabled member and can enter as a three ball, where a disabled member will be allocated to them to make a four, or they can enter as a four ball, which must include a disabled player. Each four ball will be split up into pairs and placed throughout the field.

The entry fee for this golf competition, which includes bacon roll/coffee on arrival, 18 holes of golf and a post golf clubhouse meal, is £35 for SDGP members and £40 for non-members.
