| Wednesday 8 th September | Round 2 of the Open Championship at Scotsraig from 13:04 |

Entry for this package for non UK & Ireland golfers, costs only £50.

If a golfer has the essential requirement of a coach/caddie, they will also be accommodated. Coach/caddies do not play at this event. A recognised 18-hole golf handicap is required for the Open Championship players. Open accommodation is on a twin or double room basis only. Additional accommodation must be arranged, funded and booked by the individual and is at a reduced rate of £70 per room per night (Inc continental breakfast). (Example - the SDGP will fund 3 nights accommodation for a competitor, to book an accompanying/room sharing guest, the guest would pay three nights at £35). To register your interest in the Open championship, simply fill in your details below and return the form with a non-refundable cheque payment, for £50 for the whole package, made payable to "Scottish Disability Golf Partnership" and send it to the address shown below. Open playing places are limited so it will be first-come, first served. Civic Reception seating is also limited, so players and essential coaches will be given priority. Any additional entrants to the Open will be held on a reserve list.

Please note, that at any SDGP organised golf event, all participants are responsible for their own existing medical conditions and actions, and no liability will be accepted by the SDGP or our event partners for any injury or damage to person or property. Personal injury cover is not retained and should be taken out separately if desired. All participants must inform the Committee, event organisers and their playing partners, of any medical condition which may interfere with play during an event. Participants with medication, which may need to be administered in an emergency, must inform these parties of its location and dosage.
