



SDGP MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM (For non United Kingdom & Ireland residents only)

Golfers, who live out with the United Kingdom and Ireland, who have a disability, serious health problem or mobility issue that interferes with the playing of the game of golf are invited to become members of the Scottish Disability Golf Partnership (SDGP).

The coaches of those disabled golfers, as described above, are also invited to become members. Coaches are those persons who would normally need to accompany a golfer, for example a blind or severely disabled person. Coaches may only apply for membership in conjunction with a disabled player.

For golfers & coaches (as described), membership of the SDGP is FREE

Upon acceptance, this membership offer will entitle both the disabled golfer and his/her golfing coach to:

- priority entry into all annual SDGP competitions
- voting rights, (when attending SDGP meetings)
- a chance to compete for all related competition prizes
- entry to the Scottish Order of Merit tables.

Disabled golfers entering the Pan-Disabled Open Championship in September will receive automatic membership. Coaches do not play at the Open Championship.
